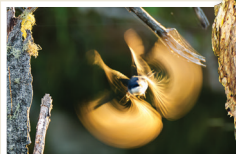
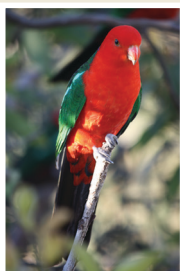




Bush Camping with Altitude

Cullendore High Country is a 4000 acre working cattle property located only two and a half hours from Brisbane. Campers have access to our property, as well as the neighbouring Maryland National Park. Our focus is to provide a quiet, family-friendly venue. The space and quiet of our campground allows visitors to interact with the many native birds and animals that frequent the campground, providing a unique backdrop to an authentic bush experience. You can enjoy mountain bike riding and walking on our many trails, birdwatching, photography, kayaking and driving along our scenic property tracks.

Campers can enjoy relaxing around their campfires in the bush, with firepits available at every site. This is combined with the luxury of flushing toilets and hot gas showers.



WELCOME TO CULLENDORE HIGH COUNTRY

Welcome to Cullendore High Country. For the safety and convenience of campers and for legal and insurance purposes we have the following CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

GENERAL RULES

- It is important to recognise that trees, particularly native trees can lose branches without warning. Set up your campsite to avoid these risks,
- No drones are to be flown on the campgrounds,
- No pets are allowed.

DRIVING

ALL road rules of NSW apply to ALL publicly accessible, private tracks/roads within the state.

This means that these road rules apply on all of the roads on our campgrounds.

WE ARE NOT A 4X4 PARK! DRIVE SEDATELY,

- All vehicles must adhere to our 15km/h speed limit, especially in camp areas,
- All vehicles must stay on our designated tracks,
- All drivers must possess a current driver's license,
- No passengers are to ride on the back of or outside vehicles.

**** Guests and any other persons who engage in any recreational activity within the meaning of the Civil Liability Act 2002 in, on or near the park, need to be aware that the pursuit of such activities may result in harm or personal injury. All persons who engage in any recreational activity do so at their own risk.***

TOILETS

- No chemicals or foreign objects are to be emptied into any septic toilet or system.
- **Dump point available on campgrounds.**

NOISE

- Noise is to be kept to a minimum (loud music, cracking whips etc. is prohibited)
- No chainsaws or electric saws are to be used,
- Generators are only to be used from 10am to 4pm.

FIRES

- No fires are to be lit during a Total Fire Ban - Gas BBQs will be provided for your use during these times,
- The location of fire pits cannot be changed.

WATER ACTIVITIES

All swimming is carried out in creeks and dams. These areas may contain submerged logs and boulders. Deeper water may be colder below the surface, which could induce cramps

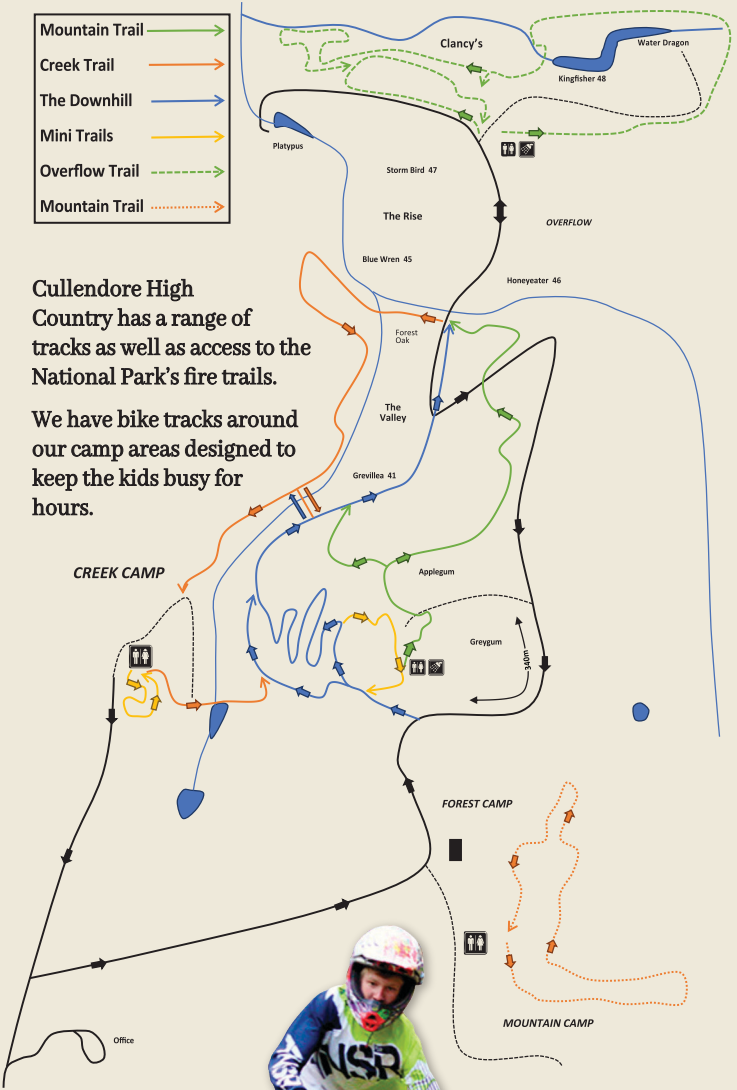
- Always supervise children when swimming.

We have bike tracks around our camp areas designed to keep the kids busy for hours.



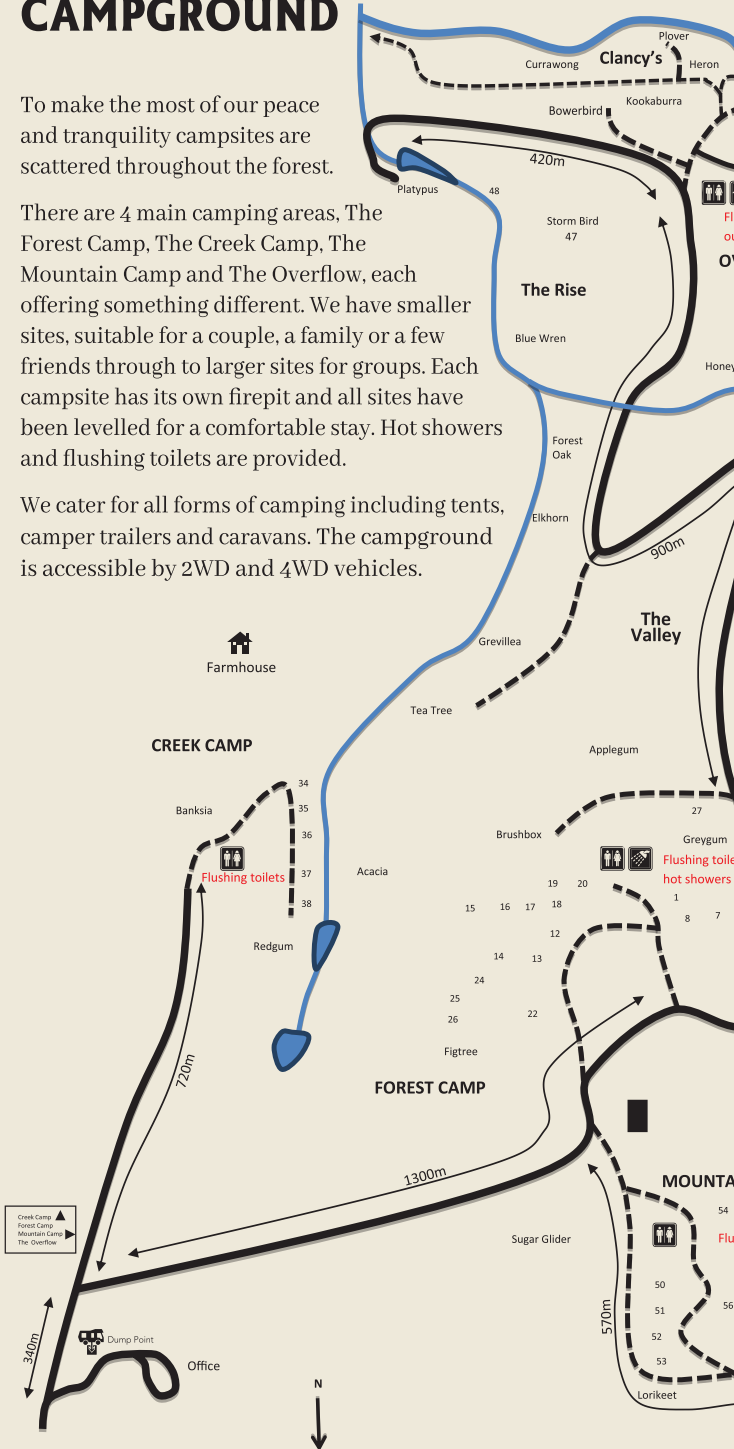
Please make sure you bring helmets and any other safety gear.

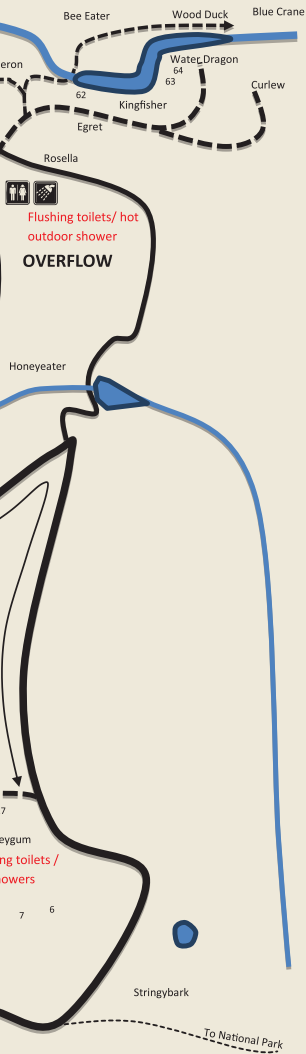
MAP OF CAMPGROUND

To make the most of our peace and tranquility campsites are scattered throughout the forest.

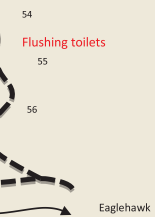
There are 4 main camping areas, The Forest Camp, The Creek Camp, The Mountain Camp and The Overflow, each offering something different. We have smaller sites, suitable for a couple, a family or a few friends through to larger sites for groups. Each campsite has its own firepit and all sites have been levelled for a comfortable stay. Hot showers and flushing toilets are provided.

We cater for all forms of camping including tents, camper trailers and caravans. The campground is accessible by 2WD and 4WD vehicles.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION

Cullendore High Country Camping owners live on site. In an emergency the owners can be contacted at their residence or by UHF channel 9 or Phone 0459 901 538.

The Emergency Evacuation map is designed to be used in emergency situations, to quickly and safely evacuate the campgrounds. An evacuation will be enacted if a situation arises that places you or your equipment at risk. This will most likely be a bushfire situation.

If an evacuation is required camp staff will visit each campsite and notify campers of the need to evacuate.

Staff will also use UHF channel 9 to inform campers of any developments. On notification of an emergency evacuation please use the evacuation routes as shown on the map.
